What is the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)?





Each district's LCAP must include the following:

- ✓ Goals
- ✓ Actions
- ✓ Related Expenditures



LCAPs must address the 8 State Priorities:

- 1. Basic services
- Implementation of standards
- 3. Parental engagement
- 4. Student achievement
- 5. Student engagement
- 6. School climate
- 7. Access to courses
- 8. Other student outcomes



LCAPs include services that target major student subgroups, including:

- √ Racial/ethnic subgroups
- ✓ Low-income students
- ✓ English learners
- ✓ Students with disabilities
- ✓ Foster youth
- ✓ Homeless youth

- Collect feedback
- Compile results
- Inform LCAP plan as part of our strategic budget development process

- Post on District website



The California School Dashboard provides parents and educators with meaningful information on school and district progress on various Indicators so they can participate in decisions to improve student learning.

- An online tool that presents:
 - Status (Very High to Very Low)
 - Change (improved or declined from prior year)
 - Student Groups (e.g., race/ethnicity and program participation)
- Released annually each fall






