<p>Personnel</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supplemental contracts for teachers to tutor students • Supplemental teachers to support instruction, reduce class sizes, provide intervention, or offer advanced academic programs • Reading teachers or subject specialists (TSA) • Instructional aides and instructional support personnel
<p>Technology</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laptops, document cameras, projectors, electronic white-boards • Software for students, including on-line subscriptions • On-line supplemental instruction, including credit recovery or classes for unavailable original credit • Materials and supplies to support the use of technology for instruction, such as printing supplies, projector bulbs, or cables
<p>Supplemental Materials/Activities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workbooks, library books • Supplemental reading books • Materials and Supplies to support instruction • Supplies for visual and performing arts instruction or activities • Supplies for music instruction
<p>Parent Involvement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent training, parent center • Home-school Liaison or parent outreach personnel • Interpreters/babysitters for meetings with parents • Supplemental parent communication of an academic nature and purpose, including production and mailing costs
